SHENANIGANZ - The Germans still wonder how to pronounce that!

Die Shenaniganz stroke their first chord in 2003. Their songs, a mixture of 70s Rock and Punk, are so incredibly close to the fathers of rock that the audience felt like they had been blown away. Comparisons with the Rolling Stones, AC/DC and Jet were on everyone's lips. From then on, the way for them is clear...to rock heaven.

The German TV program VIVA hosted the annual "SchoolJam 2006" on which the band took part for fun. Just to see how they might do. The answer was pretty definite and while other bands brought the fans by busses the Bavarians won the competition with only three fans and left 1200 bands in the gutter.

That's when the whole wheel started spinning and took the four guys on a trip through many ups and downs of a bands life.

Hundreds of gigs and some of the biggest festivals have been played (D-Rock am Ring, A-Frequency, KOR-IJAF South Korea) and they had appearances in TV and on the radio. Also two records are available world-wide, distributed by the giant SPV and released by an indie label from Munich.

The band with the often mispronounced name became awardees of the John Lennon Talent Award in 2010. Workshops and coaching in every part of show business had been absolved to proof to whole Germany that Shenaniganz are the great hope for a dying music genre.

In 2011 they even proof it to the whole world with becoming third at the Global Battle of the Bands Final in Malaysia, the highest place for Germany ever. They defeat 15 world finalists in that last round and therefor at least 5000 bands worldwide.__

And even if no German is able to pronounce the band's name, it doesn't matter because they know - Shenaniganz rocks!
